Enrollment: All levels of ability are accepted, beginners to advanced. We need a **minimum of 15 kids** to run the club – if we can't get the minimum, chess club may be cancelled.

Dates: We follow the Lake Washington District calendar - no club during days when there is no Friday afternoon school. The Spring session runs for 8 weeks – April 18, 25, May 2, 9, 16, 30 (no class May 23), June 6, 13
